

Requirements

Students must receive <u>10 hours</u> of classroom instruction and <u>6 hours</u> of "behind the wheel" driving instruction for completion of driver education. A 2007 or 2008 vehicle, which has an excellent Consumer Report safety rating, will be used for the driving portion. The classroom and driving instructor are certified by the Department of Public Safety.
