Coaching

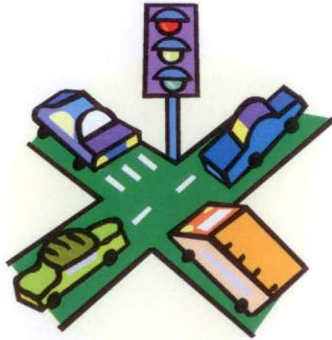
